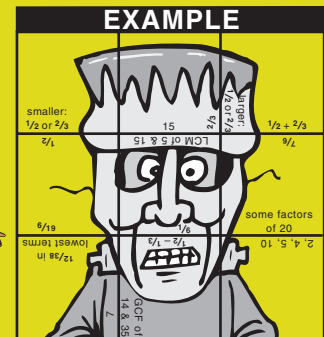


THE PATCHWORK MONSTER PUZZLE
